### CHURCH REVIVALS

#### M. E. Church

A fine program of special music will be presented tonight at the revival services in progress at the Decatur M. E. church. The young men's quartet from the Berne Mennonite church will sing three numbers. A local mixed quartet and a duet by two local ladies and the Morfords will also be on the program. We have had very fine evangelistic music and you will not want to miss this evening's service. The evangelist will bring his closing messages tonight and Saturday night at 7:30 p. m.

The American Legion band brought three numbers last night and Rev. Morford sang. An other fine crowd was in attendance. The evangelist spoke on the subject, "Six Times Under and Still a Sinner," using the story of the healing of Naaman, the leper, as the Scriptural background. He said in part:

"The story of Naaman is an interesting one because its characters are so human. Naaman was a great man, an honorable man, a man held in high esteem by his king, but he was a leper. How often we can point out many fine qualities in men but if we are as honest as the Scripture writer we are forced to end it all with a 'but'; but he is a leper. Through a captive Hebrew maiden he learned of the prophet Elisha and of a possible cure. With gifts aggregating \$80,000 in our money, he sought out the king of Israel, but Jehoram, like a good many other men in high places, was not only in no position to help him himself but had even forgotten the prophet of God who lived in his country. While he sought vainly for escape from the dilemma in which he was placed by the general from a neighboring country a message arrived from Elisha which said, 'Send him unto me and he will learn that there is a prophet in Israel.'"

"So Naaman and his retinue come to Elisha who does not even come out to greet his distinguished visitor but sends a message.
