ITALIAN WALKS OUT OF LEAGUE MEETING TODAY

Baron Aloisi Quits Meeting When Ethiopian Is Seated

Geneva, May 11.—(UPI)—Baron Aloisi, chief Italian delegate, today quit the League of Nations council table rather than sit

with the Ethiopians.

He refused also to discuss the Italo-Ethiopian conflict, on the grounds that such discussion would be without meaning.

He said the Italian contention is the only sovereign Ethio-

pean government is that of Italy.

He was back in his seat for a meeting which convened at 5:15 p. m. for a discussion of routine questions. His return indicated that Italy intends to re-

main in the league although deny-

ing its right to intervene in be-
