tinued, took 106 prisoners there, including officers, civil guards and soldiers. They also captured machine guns, sub-machine guns, rifles, one piece of artillery and five automobiles. One of the automobiles contained 5,000 pesetas in cash.

The interior ministry announced this afternoon that the loyal defense junta organized in eastern Spain had raised three columns at Valencia and another in the adjoining province of Cuenca, which would march west to reinforce the government troops.
