

**NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS**  
Notice is hereby given that Monday, November 1, 1937 will be the last day to pay your Fall installment of taxes. The county treasurer's office will be open from 8 A. M. to 4 p. m. during the tax paying season. All taxes not paid by that time will become delinquent and an 8% penalty will be added. Those who have bought or sold property and wish to have a division of taxes are asked to come in at once and call on the Auditor for errors and corrections. The Treasurer can make no corrections.

The Treasurer will not be responsible for the penalty of delinquent taxes resulting from the omission of tax-payers to see definitely what property they desire to pay into whose name it may be found, in what township or corporation it is situated.

Persons owing delinquent taxes should pay them off at the tax is such that they will be option left with the Treasurer but enforce the collection of delinquent taxes.

The annual sale of delinquent lands and lots will take place on the second Monday in April, 1938 at 10 A. M.

County orders will not be paid to anyone owing delinquent taxes. All persons are warned against them.

No receipts or checks will be held after expiration of time, as the new depositors later receive the Treasurer's daily deposit.

Particular attention: if you pay taxes in more than one township mention the fact to the Treasurer, also see that your receipts call for all your real estate and personal property.

In making inquiries of the Treasurer regarding taxes to insure repayment do not fail to include return postage.
