

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
The Board of Commissioners of the County of Adams acting by and through the Board of Hospital trustees of the Adams County Memorial Hospital, Adams County, Indiana, will receive sealed bids for an addition to and alterations to the present Adams County Memorial Hospital, said addition to consist of a separate building to be used primarily as quarters for nurses and to be erected on property adjacent to the present Adams County Memorial Hospital located in the City of Decatur, Indiana, said addition to be received until 10:00 A. M. C. S. T. on the fourth day of November, 1938, at the office of John W. Tyndall, Auditor of Adams County in the Court House at Decatur, Indiana at which time and place the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Contractors awarded work will be required to furnish acceptable surety bond in amount of 100% of the contract price.

The contract documents, including plans and specifications are on file at the office of John W. Tyndall, County Auditor of Adams County in the Court House at Decatur, Indiana, and at the office of A. M. Strauss, Architect, 415 Cal-Wayne Building, Fort Wayne, Indiana.

Copies of the documents may be obtained by depositing \$10.00 with the Auditor of Adams County, Indiana or with A. M. Strauss, Architect, 415 Cal-Wayne Building, Fort Wayne, Indiana for each set of documents so obtained. The amount of the deposit for one set of documents is refundable to each architect and bidder who returns the plans and documents in good condition within ten days after the opening of bids. \$5.00 will be refunded for each of all other sets of documents so returned.

Proposals shall be properly and completely executed on proposal form furnished by the Architect in accordance with Form 26 with non-collusion affidavit required by the statutes of Indiana and must be accompanied by Questionnaire Form 26-A. State Board of Accountants for Indiana.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check or bank draft drawn on any bank within the confines of Adams County, Indiana, and made payable to the County of Adams, State of Indiana for the benefit of the proper funds of the Board of Hospital trustees of the Adams County Memorial Hospital, or acceptable bidders' bond, executed by the bidder and surety company in an amount equal to five per cent of the bid.
