Miami Beach, Fla., March 21.—The half million dollar Palm Beach estate of gang leader Al Capone was ready to receive its new owner today and there were reports that he had reached it during the night.

white wall. It is closely guarded by family retainers who excluded all unauthorized persons. Therefore, Capone could be there with no one but members of his family knowing. A large car with Illinois license plates was parked in the yard last night.

Police, however, will know within 48 hours. A local ordinance requires any person who was ever convicted of a felony to register within that time of his arrival. If Capone has not registered by Saturday, there probably will be an inquiry in view of local and Baltimore reports.

In Baltimore it was learned that Capone had left there Tuesday morning and that the house in which he had lived while receiving
