JACKETS DOWN BERNE NINE BY SCORE OF 9-7

Decatur Tallys Six Times
In First Inning To
Down Bears

Pounding out six runs in a hectic first inning, the Decatur Yellow Jackets outlasted the Berne Bears in a wild scoring game Friday afternoon at Berne, Decatur landing on top by a 9 to 7 score.

Hits by Johnson, Koldewey, Chilcote, Koeneman, and Andrews, a walk by Lynch and a pair of Berne errors enabled the Jackets to tally their six runs in the opening frame.

Three Decatur errors, a base on balls and two hits gave Berne two runs in the same inning.

The Jackets tallied two more in the second on a base on balls, a single by Johnson and Koeneman's double. Decatur's final run scored in the sixth on a single by Schamerloh and Koeneman's second double and fourth hit of the game.

Berne tallied three in the third on a walk, two errors, and two hits. The Bears tallied their final two runs when Bury walked and scored ahead of Neunenschwander when the latter drove out a home run.

Koeneman and Johnson led the Jackets' offensive with four and three hits, respectively. Decatur presented a makeshift infield with Stapleton, regular third sacker on the sidelines with a sprained ankle suffered in the Portland game.

Three games are scheduled for the Yellow Jackets next week. Bluffton will play here Tuesday afternoon at 3:30 o'clock. The Jackets will meet Portland at Portland Thursday afternoon and Berne will play at Worthman Field Friday afternoon at 3 o'clock.
