Made Daring Raid on Japanese



Here is the type of motor torpedo boat of the U. S. navy's "mosquito fleet" which made a daring raid into a western Philippine bay at night and blasted a 5,000-ton Japanese vessel in the face of fire of shore batteries. The small boat, capable of speed of at least 40 knots, or 46 miles per hour, made the daring raid into Binanga bay, inside the entrance to Subic bay, and opposite side of the Bataan peninsula from Manila bay. The small boat is armed with four 18-inch torpedo tubes and four machine guns in power-operated turrets.
