years the tourney has been held here consecutively. The Pleasant Mills Spartans won the 1940 and 1942, the Decatur Yellow Jackets in 1941 and 1944, and Monroe Bearcats in 1943.

In these five years, however, Decatur sectional has produced champions of the Huntington regional tourney. Monroe was regional in 1943 and the Yellow Jackets repeated the feat last year, with both teams falling before Fort Wayne in the opening round of the state semi-final tournament.
