Some Violence  
Is Reported In  
Parts Of Italy

Communists Make  
Formal Demand To  
Share In Cabinet

Rome, Apr. 21 — (UP) — Violence broke out in both the north and south of Italy today in the wake of Premier Alcide De Gasperi's crushing victory over the communists.

Ten persons were injured in the Foggia area of the south last night and early today when police and army reinforcements used tear gas bombs to break up communist demonstrations in three towns protesting government election "fraud."

Two more ammunition dumps were attacked in the Milan area and one soldier was wounded. High military sources in Milan said all troops and Carabinieri were placed on the alert in the Milan-Genoa area where the situation was described as "tense." These developments coincided with formal communist demands for participation in the new government and threats of a nationwide wave of "dangerous ten" strikes if refused.

At the same time the communist front began to crumble under the impact of De Gasperi's victory. A group of six leftwing socialist leaders presented leftwing socialist chief Pietro Nenni with a demand their party quit the leftist alliance.

Official final returns on the two-day Italian election confirmed De Gasperi's smashing victory. They gave De Gasperi's Christian Democratic party 48.7 percent of the vote for the assembly and 47.9 percent of the senate.

Communists won 30.7 percent in the assembly and 31 percent in the senate.

Reports from Foggia said Carabinieri forces were ordered into action throughout the "bloody Puglia" region to put down the wave of communist demonstrations. The riots were said to be the worst since the communist-led strikes last November.

One demonstration of 1,000 persons started at midnight in San Severo, north of Foggia. Speakers charged election returns issued by the government were a "fake." Police and Carabinieri were unable to break up the crowds. Troops rushed in from Foggia and dispersed the mob with tear gas.

At 2 a. m. another 350 leftists met in the central square in Apricena, listening to loudspeakers.

Redkey High School  
Returns To NormalBrief Walkout At  
School Is Ended

Redkey, Ind., April 21 — (UP) — All of Redkey high school's pupils returned to their classes today after a brief demonstration yesterday in protest against the apparent "dismissal" of one of their teachers.

School superintendent J. Russell Hiatt said that a meeting was held last night at which the situation was explained to students. He said they were told Leland Lemming, mathematics teacher, had not been dismissed from his job, but only that he had not been re-employed for the 1948-49 school year.

Many of the students paraded around the school building yesterday carrying placards stating "we want Lemming."

Hiatt said the "rumors had circulated" that the school's senior class students would be unable to take their annual sightseeing trip to the eastern part of the country. Lemming, class sponsor, will accompany the class on the trip.

Fear that they would not be able to take the trip because the teacher had been "dismissed" was "probably the immediate reason" for the brief walkout by the students.
