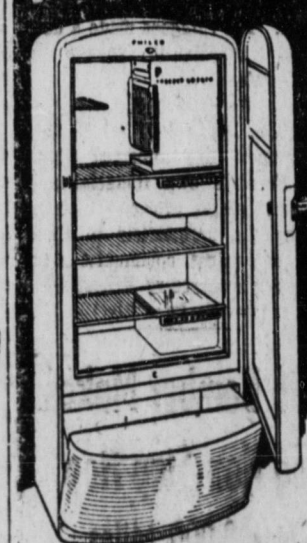

Arb Greenlee, 22, Indianapolis, told police that he and Joseph Collier, 20, and Gerald Pennington, both of Indianapolis, struck Mrs. Weak with a pistol before robbing her. Greenlee said they decided to rob her because he knew she kept large amounts of cash in her home.

A blood-spattered gun was found in an ice box at Greenlee's home, police said.

said. An informant source close to Generalissimo Chiang Kai-Shek's government said that Chinese authorities would welcome landing of American marines, but would "lost face" if they asked for such action. This source said the Chinese communists would seize upon a nationalist request for a marine landing to denounce Chiang's government again on charges of "selling out" Shanghai to foreign interests.

Many Chinese privately express hope the marines will come, however. They feel a landing would stabilize the situation here, and

point out that Tsingtau, although ringed by powerful Red forces, has not been attacked. They believe this is because U. S. and marine forces are there.

The tiny village of Penitencia, miles southwest of McAllen, is reportedly the oldest in Texas. It founded between 1525 and 1530.
