AGAIN URGING a 50-year-old plan for a canal across Nicaragua to link the Atlantic and the Pacific, Nicaragua offers the U. S. 99-year leases for defense bases at the Gulf of Fonseca and the Corn Islands (arrows) as a means of strengthening continental security. The canal and passage would run 11 miles from the Pacific to Lake Nicaragua, 60 miles across the lake, 90 miles down San Juan river to Greytown. Such a passage would save 1,100 miles of travel compared to Panama canal route from U. S., it is claimed.
