Capt. Ted Schindler Remains Enroute Home

Berne, May 19 — Mrs. John W. Schindler of Berne has received a telegram from the war department stating that the remains of her son, Capt. Ted K. Schindler, are enroute to this country from Italy. Because of the manner in which he met death the remains cannot be identified individually. For this

reason the remains and the remains of his comrades will be buried in Jefferson Barracks, national cemetery, Jefferson Barracks, Mo. Capt. Schindler was the pilot of a B-24 Liberator and was shot down over the Brenner Pass in Italy, February 28, 1945. The 12 crew members were all killed and were believed buried in one grave in Italy. Schindler is survived by his

mother and two brothers. He was 23 years of age at the time he was killed.

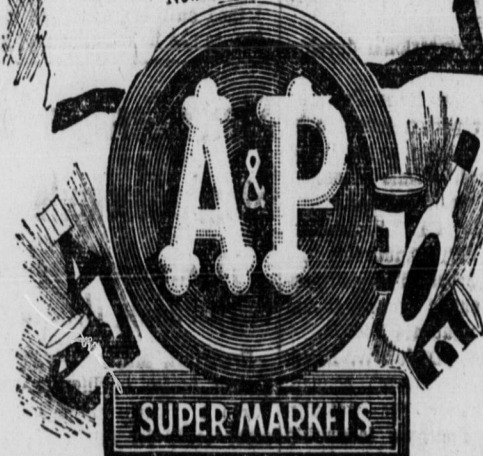
