

## Calland Speaks At Soybean Field Day

### To Inspect Plots West Of Frankfort

J. Ward Calland, managing director of the National Soybean improvement council and a member of the board of trustees of Purdue University, will be one of the major speakers at Indiana's soybean field day to be held one mile west of Frankfort Tuesday, Sept. 20. Inspection tours of 50 soybean plots will be one of the features of the day.

Calland, working in conjunction with extension services in the soybean belt states, has made an extensive study of soybean production methods in the last few years and has edited several publications covering farmer's practices. Due

to his close contact with the soybean processing industry, he is also familiar with industrial uses of the crop and will cover both the production and utilization phases in his talk.

Other interesting features announced by Arden Russell, Clinton county agricultural agent, and Purdue agronomists cooperating in the program will be inspection tours and a visit to a modern solvent extraction plant. Trips will be made over 50 plots planted with various varieties of soybeans and having different fertilizer treatments and various rates and methods of planting. Purdue agronomists will conduct visitors on these tours, which will be followed by a demonstration of a new type self-propelled combine. The morning program will end with an inspection trip to a modern solvent extraction plant located just west of Frankfort.

A luncheon will be held at noon and in the afternoon, Calland and other speakers vitally interested in Indiana agriculture will combine to present various phases of this major Indiana crop program. The program of the day is expected to be one of the best in recent years in this field.

helped restore normalcy to Paris, defeated in 1940. The average Frenchman is living almost as well, eating almost as well and wearing clothes almost as good as in 1939.

Shops are full of meat and cheese and butter. Only coffee, sugar, rice and cooking oil are rationed. The big headache is the 1,700 percent rise in the cost of living since 1939, offset only by a 1,000 percent increase in wages, since 1939.

In Britain, the sides of beef no longer lie steaming on the great

silver serving trolleys at such restaurants as Simpson's and The Savoy. Instead, one can order a wholemeat steak for lunch. Housewives supplement their menus with seagull eggs and a fish called Snook.

Clothes no longer are rationed, but Britons still are pretty threadbare. The home of Scotch whisky no longer can offer it to its own because so much must be exported to help pay for Britain's essential imports.

Meat and butter, cheese and canned fish, sugar, soap and tea—all these basic commodities are rationed to keep down the import bill.

In defeated Germany, life has improved. Britons complain that "Jerry" now has an easier life than the average Briton. Almost every observer agrees that the German is eating better, provided he has the marks to buy, than the Briton who helped defeat him.

True, German towns are battered, the countryside occupied, and the nation split in the east-west cold war.

But German industry is almost intact despite bombs and dismantling. Ruhr coal mines are disgorging millions of tons of fuel for the industry of western Europe. The grains are growing golden on the slopes of Bavaria, and, to the north, the cattle are fattening in Holstein.

Except for a few still rationed items, west Germans eat at least as well as in 1939, if not better. For there is no "guns-or-butter" program to sweep the food from their tables.

In the Soviet zone of Germany, however, the picture is bleak. Best available information indicates that the living standard is far below 1939. And the official ration theoretically provides only 1,500 calories per person daily, compared with 3,000 before the war.
