



Noblesville, Ind., Jan. 9—(UPI)—Excavation and remodeling work was blamed today for the collapse of two buildings in the heart of this city's business district.

A passer-by, Clyde Carson, 33, suffered minor injuries when he was struck by a brick. Total damage was not estimated immediately.

The three-story Zeebel Clothing Store, where workers had been digging in the basement during remodeling work, toppled over yesterday onto an adjacent two-story building housing a cleaning establishment. Both structures on the south side of the public square were wrecked.

### Credit, Debit Sides Presented By Pres. Truman

Washington, Jan. 9—(UPI)—Here are the "credit" and "debit" sides of the 1951 "ledger" as described by President Truman in his state of the Union address.

#### Credits

1. The United Nations "turned back the Chinese Communists in Korea."

2. U. S. aid "helped our allies to hold back the Communist advance" in Indo-China and Malaya.

3. "We strengthened the chances of peace in the Pacific" by treaties with Japan and defense pacts with Australia, New Zealand and the Philippines.

4. "In Europe, combined defense has become a reality."

5. European security was strengthened by the agreement to bring Greece and Turkey into the North Atlantic treaty organization.

6. "The United Nations, the world's great hope for peace, has come through a year of trial strong and more useful than ever."

7. The "foolproof inspection system" of disarmament offered in the U. S. by the United States, Britain and France, but spurned by Russia.

8. America's armed forces enlarged by more than 1,000,000 men and women.

9. "Rapid progress in the field of atomic weapons" and production of \$16,000,000,000 worth of military supplies and equipment.

10. "Economic conditions in the country are good."

#### Debits

1. Russia "continued to expand its military production and increase its already excessive military power."

2. "At home our defense preparations are far from adequate."

3. "Difficulties and delays in designing and producing the latest types of airplanes and tanks. Some machine tools and metals are still in extremely short supply."

4. "Severe economic problems" in other free nations as a result of the defense buildup.

5. "Political tensions" in the middle east and the Iranian oil dispute.
