Strong counter-attacks pushed the Reds back from their conquered ground.

The French high command said the rebel knockout attempt, coming 19 days after the first Red assault on the bastion, 180 miles west of Hanoi, began late Tuesday.

French military spokesmen said the "fighting fools" defending the encircled position not only bettered the Reds in vicious hand-to-hand combat but launched "a powerful French Union counter-attack."
