Finds New Method For Fingerprinting

NEW YORK (UPI)—A young detective's revolutionary method of getting at-the-scene fingerprints received enthusiastic backing from the world's police chiefs today, as one of the greatest developments in crime investigation in 20 years.

Nasau (N.Y.) County Detective Matthew Bonora, 31, who has worked on such famous cases as the Peter Weinberger kidnapping and the abduction of Stephen Damman, said he has received orders from police departments in almost every state for his fingerprint taking development.

"We've also got orders from police chiefs in Mexico, Venezuela, Ghana, Liberia, Canada, all over," Bonora said in an interview with United Press International at the convention of the International Association of Police Chiefs here.

"The response is terrific and we think it's really going to help law enforcement a lot. This little thing will help fight crime throughout the world," he said.

Bonora's idea was simple—to a housewife. It's an aerosol can that sprays fingerprint powder, much like the cans used in every household for shaving cream, insecticide or whipped cream. To help him overcome technical difficulties, Bonora brought in two partners—William Golden, 39, a fingerprint technician for the Nassau police, and George Hartz, 51, his next-door neighbor and an aerosol chemist.

Bonora, a policeman for 10 years, said he was constantly annoyed by the long, hard and dirty job of trying to get fingerprints the old way—a system developed 20 years ago and never changed. He also knew that often a policeman who was not a fingerprint expert would ruin the prints he was trying to take.

Tyrone Power's Mother Is Dead

CANTERBURY, N.H. (UPI)—The mother of the late actor Tyrone Power died Tuesday without ever learning that her son died nearly a year ago.

Mrs. Patricia Power, 77, who has been ill since before the death of the actor last Nov. 15, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Anne Hardenbergh. The news of Power's death had been kept from her.

Brother-In-Law Of Hobbs Is Acquitted

ALBION, Ind. (UPI)—Walter E. Campbell, 41, brother-in-law of convicted embezzler Arnold G. Hobbs, was declared innocent of embezzlement charges Tuesday night by an Albion Circuit Court jury.

Campbell was accused of aiding and abetting Hobbs in the embezzlement of \$3,400 from the Noble County Credit Union during July 1957.

The jury of 10 men and two women deliberated nearly two hours before returning the verdict. The trial began Sept. 21.

Hobbs now is serving a 15 year prison sentence on an embezzlement conviction earlier this year in Allen Circuit Court.

The two men were indicted after a state audit revealed that more than two million dollars was missing from credit union funds.
