## Social Security Quiz Answers Many Queries

(Editor's Note) Do you have any questions about Social Security? We all do, don't we? Send any question you might have to Social Security Quiz, c/o Daily Democrat. You'll find your answer in this column, which is published regularly.

1. Q. My 25 year old son has been disabled since he was eleven years old and I have been his sole support. Is he entitled to any benefits from social security?

A. If your son's disability is of such a nature that it meets the definition of disability as required by the social security law, he will be entitled to benefits, if he is still dependent upon you, when you reach 65 and become entitled to monthly payments. If you should die fully insured under social security and your son is dependent, payments may be due him at that time. The mother of a disabled son or daughter who is entitled to disabled child's benefits, may also qualify for benefits, regardless of her age, if she has her child in her care.

2. Q. I am receiving social security benefits and expect to change my mailing address soon. If I leave a change of address with the post office, will that be all I need to do to get my checks at my new address?

A. No. You should also file a change of address with the social security administration. This may be done by either calling at your local social security office or by mailing a notice to the social security payment center from which your checks are received.

3. Q. My husband and I received a notice that our social security checks will be combined in one check. My husband is out of town a lot and it will delay me getting my money if I must wait for him to get back to town to sign it. Is there any way I can continue getting my check separate from his?

A. Combining checks will save the government an estimated \$1 million a year. You may, however, get your check just as you always have if a combined check would be inconvenient.

4. Q. How long will it take to change the address on my check after I file notice of a change?

A. If you mail the notice so that it reaches the payment center in the beginning of the month, your check for that month will usually be sent to your new address. If the notice is received later, the new address will be on your check for the following month.

5. Q. What information about my

1959 wages should I bring with me when I come to the social security office to apply for benefits early in 1960?

A. If you are going to apply for social security benefits before July 1, 1960, you should bring in either your withholding statement, Form W-2, for the year 1959 or a signed statement of earnings from your employer. If you had more than one employer during 1959, you should furnish the information from all employers. This will help speed the processing of your claim.

6. Q. What form should I use to change the address on my social security checks?

A. You can have the address changed by completing and mailing one of the self-addressed cards that were given you when you applied for benefits. If you've lost them, visit your social security office.

7. Q. My brothers and I have a partnership. We employ our father answering the phone, watching the store when we are out, and occasionally unloading merchandise. Can we report him for social security so he can draw benefits at 65?

A. No. You cannot report the employment of a parent, spouse or child under 21 for social security purposes. If one of the partners were a non-relative, your father could then be covered by social security.
