Key Question For Finch Murder Trial

LOS ANGELES (UPI) — How far was Dr. Bernard Finch standing from his wife the night the gun he held killed her?

It is a key question in the murder trial of the surgeon and red-haired Carole Tregoff. It affects vitally the defense that Mrs. Barbara Finch was killed accidentally.

A prosecution chemist was scheduled to testify today that Finch was from three to six feet from his wife Barbara Jean Finch when the fatal shot entered her back.

Gunpowder On Dress — Clifford C. Crump, the chemist, made that estimate on the evidence of gunpowder fragments found in the back of the white cocktail dress worn by the victim the night she was killed outside the \$60,000 Finch home in West Covina.

Finch's attorney, Grant Cooper, had offered to concede previously that a gun held by Finch killed his tennis-playing wife.

Cooper scored some ground Monday with admission from an autopsy surgeon that the items found in the so-called "murder kit" discovered on the murder scene could far more reasonably be used for innocent purposes.

Found Outside Garage — Among them was a kitchen knife (for carving meat or bread — said Cooper), a clothesline (for securing bumpers on Finch's boat), seasonal and syringes (normal parts of a doctor's equipment) and a flashlight (not unusual for anyone).

The incriminating part was finding the attic case with such items just outside the double garage where the state charges Mrs. Barbara Finch was attacked outside her red convertible.

Finch's mistress has an explanation. Miss Tregoff has said the doctor called her to bring up the flashlight the night of Mrs. Finch's killing and that she brought the whole case instead.

Red Pilot Defects But Dies In Crash

TAIPEI, Formosa (UPI) — The first Chinese Communist pilot to defect to the Nationalist Chinese on Formosa crashed his MIG jet fighter on the island's east coast today — but apparently was killed in the crash.

Nationalist Chinese officials announced the defection but did not say what happened to the pilot. Other sources, however, said he was killed.

Gen. Peng Meng Nih, chief of the Nationalist general staff, told the official Central News Agency that the Communist ordered the pilot to return to his base and sent nine groups of jets up when he refused. The other MIGs failed to intercept him, he said.

Rear Adm. Liu Hoh-tu said that the jet landed with slight damage on the east coast of Formosa.

It was the first reported defection of a Communist plane to the Nationalists since the Nationalists were driven off the mainland to Formosa in 1949.

The Communist radio announced that one of their MIGs left Lu Chiao, a coastal airbase on the mainland, early this morning and had not been heard from.

It asked residents of Chekiang and Fukien coastal provinces to look for the plane.

A Taipei newspaper said the Nationalists intercepted the Red broadcast and started their own search, but Nationalist air forces denied reports. Officials also denied reports the MIG was shot down by Nike-Hercules guided missiles.

Nationalist air force Col. Hu Chen-Hsiang told newsmen the Red pilot attempted to land on the east coast beach — across the island from the Formosa Strait — and plowed into the sand killing the pilot. Hu said the plane was "not too badly wrecked," but he refused news photographers requests to take pictures of the plane.

Charges Kidnaping Of Chinese Diplomat

LONDON (UPI) — Communist China charged today that members of the U.S. consulate-general kidnaped a Chinese diplomat in Bombay, India, in an incident that led to the beating of an American Marine in November.

Peiping Radio, in a New China News Agency dispatch from Bombay, quoted the text of a statement issued by the Communist Chinese consulate-general in Bombay giving its version of the incident. The Peiping broadcast was monitored here.

It said Chang Chien-yu, a staff member of the Bombay Chinese consulate, "was kidnaped by members of the U.S. consulate-general in Bombay" on Nov. 26, 1959.

The Americans held Chang in the consulate by force "and threatened to kill him if he stuck to his refusal" to apply for "political asylum" in the United States, the statement said.

The Communist version was diametrically opposed to the U.S. version of the incident.

According to the U.S. version, Marine Sgt. Robert Armstrong, attached to the U.S. consulate in Bombay, was dragged into the Chinese consulate by four Communists and was beaten and threatened when he attempted to recover a tape-recorded statement Chang made in voluntarily requesting asylum.



Out Our Way



Nikita Khrushchev Sends Gifts To Ike

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Soviet Premier Nikita S. Khrushchev probably never heard of Emily Post. But she would be proud of the way he handled an international etiquette problem by sending gifts on two holidays.

Christmas is just another cold day in December to the avowedly atheistic Russians. Nevertheless, Khrushchev sent President Eisenhower a plane full of Christmas gifts on Dec. 19.

The Soviet boss also sent Christmas presents to the four Eisenhower grandchildren.

Then Monday Khrushchev sent Eisenhower two more large gift packages containing New Year's presents: New Year's Day is the holiday on which Russians exchange gifts.

White House Press Secretary James C. Hagerty said one of the New Year's boxes held caviar. He said he did not know what was in the other package.

The latest Khrushchev presents were delivered by Soviet Ambassador Mikhail M. Menshikov during a 20-minute White House conference. He also relayed an oral message from the Soviet premier.

Brings Goodwill Message — Menshikov would not reveal to newsmen the text of Khrushchev's message. He said only, "I brought a goodwill message from Chairman Khrushchev to the President and also conveyed Mr. Khrushchev's New Year greetings to the President and all his family."

Khrushchev's Christmas gift to Eisenhower last month was a plane load of 120 assorted trees, plants and shrubs.

When the plants are released from quarantine, they will be sent to Eisenhower's Gettysburg, Pa., farm.

It is not known what, if any, Christmas or New Year's gifts Eisenhower sent Khrushchev.

Indiana Smut Law Is Ruled Invalid

INDIANAPOLIS (UPI) — A Marion County judge today ruled that the Indiana smut law is unconstitutional.

Judge Richard M. Salb dismissed in Marion Criminal Court 11 cases in which defendants were charged in 1959 with possessing obscene literature.

Salb said his ruling was based on a recent decision of the U.S. Supreme Court in connection with a Los Angeles city ordinance prohibiting the sale of obscene literature.

Prosecutor Philip H. Bayt said he will appeal one of the cases to the Indiana Supreme Court.

Salb said in a nine-page opinion that in the Los Angeles case, the ordinance was held unconstitutional by unanimous opinion of the high court on grounds that possession did not mean the defendants had knowledge of the contents of questionable publications.

"The ultimate decision of the Supreme Court was unanimous and I am bound by it," Salb said.
