### Continue Hearing On Rate Increase

INDIANAPOLIS (UPI)—The Indiana Public Service Commission, which earlier rejected a plea by 11 rural electric cooperatives to intervene in a private utility rate increase case, reversed itself late Wednesday and permitted them to be represented.

The PSC continued hearings on the rate boost for the second time and scheduled the next session for Feb. 17.

Public Service Company of Indiana, the state's biggest private utility, is seeking a five million dollar rate increase in the 69 Indiana counties it serves. Its proposed rate increase would not affect rates to the REMCs, which buy power wholesale from the utility.

The commission rejected a motion by Public Counselor George L. Diven that the case should be dismissed on grounds the law requires the entire rate structure be reviewed.

The 11 cooperatives served by the firm are Boone, Carroll, Daviess-Martin, Decatur, Johnson, Knox, Fayette-Union, Hancock, Miami-Cass, Orange and Tipmont, Tipton and Montgomery Counties.

### Household Scrapbook By ROBERTA LEE

## Rice

An easy way to wash rice is to place it in a sieve and let the cold water continue to run through until it comes through clear and free from starch. Rice should always be washed before using.

## Glass Stopper

If a glass bottle stopper sticks, revolve the neck of the bottle slowly in the heat of a burning match. The heat from this will cause the neck to expand, thereby releasing the stopper.

## Nail Polish Stains

Fingernail polish stains can be removed from all fabrics, except acetate rayon, plexon and vinylon, with acetone or fingernail polish remover. Pure amyl acetate (banana oil) can safely be used on rayon and vinylon. Saturate the spot first with carbon tetrachloride, then apply a drop or two of amyl acetate to the stain. Brush lightly upward with a soft cloth to pick up the dissolved polish.

## Plaster

Small nail holes and cracks in white plaster walls can be filled in by patting in ordinary baking soda. It is a good idea to fill up all these holes and cracks in this manner before painting the walls.

## Sardine Sandwiches

When making sardine sandwiches, chop a pickle into the sardine paste. This will add materially to the taste.

## Household Glue

For a handy household glue, try the following: To one cup of granulated laundry starch, add enough water to produce a liquid of whipping-cream consistency. Then, bring the mixture to a boil, and allow it to cool.

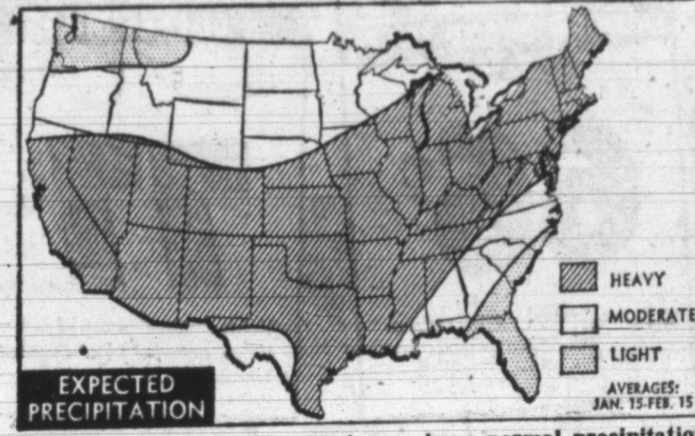

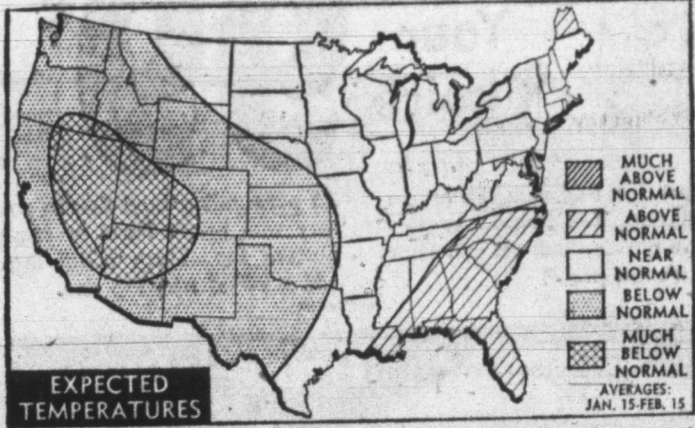
