Floor Washer Scrubs, Vacuum-Drys

Finding New Uses For Paper Towels

Modern paper towels, familiar as a necessary accessory in the kitchen, are extending their service into other areas of today's homes. The bathroom, garage, basement workshop, recreation room and laundry are among the new locations where paper towels are finding a welcome, it is said.

In the family bathroom, paper towels are useful—and acceptable—for those quick mop ups which don't qualify as a full scale face-wash or a major bath. In homes with small children, it's a saving on laundry and extra work to have a paper towel dispenser at a height low enough for toddlers to reach. This is true only if you train them to throw the towels away in a handy waste receptacle after the drying operation.

In guest bathrooms, dainty guest finger towels are still "the thing," but even here paper towels are finding more and more acceptance. In the garage, paper towels are used for cleaning the windshield and other glass areas of the family car. They're handy, too, for cleaning oil and exhaust stains from the power mower, wiping off garden tools and dozens of other so-called "wiping" chores. Be sure to provide a waste container close to the towel dispenser, however. One of the chief attractions of paper towels to modern men-in-a-hurry is their easy, quick disposability. And, men being as they are, the used towels might be thrown anywhere unless a waste receptacle is provided.

In the recreation room, keep a paper towel dispenser close to the table tennis, billiard, darts or other play areas for quick hand-drying. If the "tree" room boasts an adjoining powder room, equip this room exclusively with paper towels and tissues. In the laundry, you'll want the towels handy when you apply hand lotion after the family wash—and during it, too, to dry your hands. Though paper towels are essentially a utilitarian item in your home, consider the decor of the various rooms in which you might put up a roll.

Let Metal Weather

When you move into a new house, don't paint any of the galvanized metal until it has "weathered" for at least six months. If it's necessary to paint sooner, prepare the metal by washing it with household vinegar.

Give Unused Room, Attic A Function

An unused upstairs bedroom or attic room can be transformed into a delightful playroom for the children or an attractive apartment for their grandparents. Preparation and planning is very important to the success of a remodeling project, especially when the room's function is to be changed.

Once the purpose of the room—playroom, small apartment or den—has been decided, a decorating plan must be formulated. This plan should include the necessary building materials, furnishings and extra equipment. The entire renovation should be budgeted so that expenses can be kept to a minimum.

A popular paneling material for walls and ceilings is plastic surfaced, which has a permanent finish that never requires refinishing. Decorative as well as practical, the paneling is available at lumber dealers in plain colors, wood-grains and marble patterns.

To increase the storage potential of a remodeled bedroom or attic of a remodeled bedroom or attic of plastic-surfaced hardboard also form.

The paneling can be installed over solid backing or furring strips. Special adhesive assures a strong bond. Most home handy-men can apply the panels. The only tools needed are a hammer, saw and level.

16-inch square blocks, which are recommended by architects for ceiling installations are also available. The blocks have tongue-and-groove edges which simplify installation.

A room paneled with plastic-surfaced hardboard can withstand hard wear, but still be cleaned in a jiffy. Occasional damp-wiping keeps the paneling clean.

Turn Pantry Into Office And Laundry

The trend in recent years has been to consolidate the old-fashioned pantry with the kitchen, but many homemakers have transformed the pantry into a well-equipped utility room and home office.

A small desk, telephone and work area provide the homemaker with her own private area, for writing or talking. If the pantry is large enough, a laundry center can be included. Appliances can be located under the working surface, and concealed by sliding perforated doors.

To brighten the decor of the pantry, panel the walls with plastic-surfaced paneling in a pleasant color. Practical as well as decorative, plastic-surfaced hardboard has a permanent surface that can be damp-wiped clean in a jiffy. Heat and moisture do not affect this paneling, and important consideration if laundry facilities are included in the pantry. The paneling's durable plastic surface never requires painting or refinishing.

Handy Kitchen Device Has 'Million' Uses

A practical addition to any kitchen is an under-the-cabinet drawer on casters. Use it for children's games, balls, dolls and small toys. Every family will find its own uses for this handy device.

To make it, form a framework of 1 by 4-inch lumber for the sides. To the framework nail a piece of 1/4" hardboard. This long-wearing, silver-free surface is ideal for handling by youngsters. Now add casters at the corners, a couple of door pulls and some paint to match the kitchen decor. It'll be just about the handiest piece of equipment in the kitchen.

Large Closet Can Be Turned Into Laundry

A home handyman can transform a seldom-used basement closet into a compact laundry center by paneling the walls with moisture-resistant paneling and installing sliding doors to conceal the appliances.

Leftover scraps of the plastic-surfaced hardboard can be used to surface overhead shelves. The smooth plastic surface of the paneling will not snag sheer wearing apparel. The paneling does not require painting or any finishing work.

Space permitting, pull-out compartments for soiled clothes can be built adjoining the washer and dryer. Perforated hardboard in a color matching or harmonizing with the paneling can be used on the fronts of the storage units to provide adequate ventilation.

Plastic-surfaced hardboard also is available at lumber yards in easy-to-handle 16" square blocks, which can be used on the ceiling of the converted closet. Sliding doors can be obtained to close off the new laundry center when not in use.

Inside Shutters Used As Chalk, Bulletin Boards

Inside window shutters offer both style and utility value, especially when they're installed in a youngster's room.

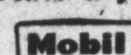
Made of two pieces of 1/4" tempered Presdwood glued together back to back so the smooth sides are exposed, the shutters when closed form an attractive bulletin board for displaying favorite photos, pennants and other prize possessions. When open, they form a chalkboard for doing homework assignments, writing memos or keeping track of important dates.

The inside surface, which will be used as a bulletin board, should be painted to harmonize or contrast with the decor of the rest of the room. The other side is painted with either green or black chalk-board paint.
