

## Adenauer Worries On Ike Indecisiveness

### Advise Queries On Baby-Sitter Health

INDIANAPOLIS (UPI) — A 23-year-old Muncie woman lies near death while health officials try to locate all the families for whom she had worked as a baby-sitter so they could receive tuberculin tests.

Indiana State Board of Health officials said the occurrence is comparatively rare but stressed "it could happen again because of the way in which people select their baby-sitters."

In the Muncie case, the woman apparently had not suspected the nature of her ailment until she went to a physician with a 102-degree fever.

She was found to have advanced pulmonary tuberculosis and also tubercular pneumonia. She was too ill to list all the families for whom she had worked as a baby-sitter and authorities were fearful that a number of children may have become infected through her.

#### Don't Question Health

Dr. Andrew C. Offutt, commissioner of the Indiana State Board of Health, and president of the Middle States Public Health Association, commented that "many people trust their children to almost anyone with no thought of the health qualifications of the sitter."

But Adenauer is a sensitive man. He reacts quickly to statements such as the President's remark Wednesday that any Soviet attempt to cut West Berlin's connections with the western world would cause a grave situation.

Adenauer believes the United States, on whose guarantee West Berlin's security depends, should take a more forward position. 

These deaths are at the rate of approximately six per 100,000 population, compared to the rate of 19.4 in 1900, 8.6 in 1925 and 19.9 in 1950.

Kelly said that while TB officials do not try to single out any one group, such as baby-sitters, they do try to concentrate their testing work on all persons who by occupation are potentially dangerous to the public, should they have the disease. These include food handlers, barbers, beauticians and others.

## Advise Acceptance Of Damaged Parcels

"Don't be afraid to accept damaged parcel post," says postmaster Leo Kirsch.

Reluctance to accept insured or c.o.d. parcels which arrive in bad condition is based upon a misunderstanding that the right to file for indemnity will thereby be jeopardized.

## New Requirements On Filing Extension

Sterling M. Dietrich, district director of internal revenue, announced today new requirements relating to extension of time for filing individual income tax returns. The new requirements are contained in treasury decision 6436 and are effective for taxable years beginning after December 31, 1958.

Individuals requesting an extension of time for filing their income tax returns must furnish the following information:

1. The reasons why more time is needed.
2. For how long.
3. Whether they filed and made timely payments on any required declaration of estimated tax for the year involved.
4. Whether each return for the last three years was filed on time or filed within an approved extension of time.


