More than 1,000 persons are taking a college course in Old Testament being offered on television in Washington, D.C. A Methodist minister and a rabbi are teaching the course. The television station owned by the Washington Evening Star donates the time.

The United States National Health Survey reports that church related hospitals in the United States gave care to 4,657,000 patients during the last fiscal year, more than one-fourth of all patients treated in American hospitals.

The church farthest south in the world has just been dedicated by the Deep Freeze outpost in Antarctica. It is a sixteen-foot-square chapel with a cross and a steeple above it. An inscription on the wall says, "Now it can truly said that the earth turns on a point of faith."
