

More Snow Flutters Down Over Indiana

More snow flutters down on Indiana today with winter still very much in command of the weather as spring neared. Weathermen said light snow was falling all around the state this morning. But it added little to the cover ranging in depth from 2 to 11 inches still left from a series of storms that began Feb. 25.

Scattered light snow and flurries were expected today, with a one-day lull Friday and the likelihood that snow would be resumed Saturday.

Snow measurements this morning included 11 inches at South Bend, 9 at Goshen, 7 at Lafayette, 4 at Evansville, 3 at Fort Wayne and 2 at Indianapolis.

Update areas got several inches of new snow Wednesday, and gusty winds caused considerable drifting that closed schools and blocked highways. Some of the schools closed Wednesday reopened this morning.

The new snow iced highways and made driving hazardous again. With spring only three days away, there was no indication of an early warmup from the subnormal temperatures which have thrived throughout Hoosierland for the last three weeks.

Highs Wednesday ranged from 35 at Fort Wayne and South Bend to 42 at Evansville; warmest readings recorded recently. The mercury dropped to lows in the 20s this morning, including 24 at Lafayette, 25 at Indianapolis, 26 at Fort Wayne 27 at South Bend and 28 at Evansville.

Highs today will range from the upper 20s to the mid 30s, lows tonight from 20 to 25, and highs Friday from the mid 30s to 40.

Plan Hearings For Striking Packers

CHICAGO (UPI)—The cases of 51 striking meatworkers accused of violence in the Wilson & Co. strike will go before a special hearing next week, it was announced here today.

The hearing also will dispose of charges of non-violent strike infractions against 41 other members of the United Packinghouse Workers of America, federal Judge Joseph Sam Perry said.

Perry was a member of the three-man arbitration board which Wednesday ordered 233 former strikers reinstated to their jobs by April 4.

The 233 had been charged with mass picketing tactics, but Perry said the panel was convinced their names had been taken in spot checks of the picket lines at Wilson plants.

"They just happened to be there at the time the checks were made," Perry said. "I'm realistic enough to know that all the strikers were on the picket lines at one time or another during the strike."

Perry appointed David J. Shipman, master in chancery, to begin hearings on the 92 remaining cases by the end of next week.

The 233 union members reinstated Wednesday will be among the more than 3,000 former strikers who will replace non-union workers on Wilson production lines.

The arbitration board ruled last week that all Wilson workers should be hired on a strict seniority basis, giving most jobs to union members who were replaced by non-union help during the 112-day strike.






