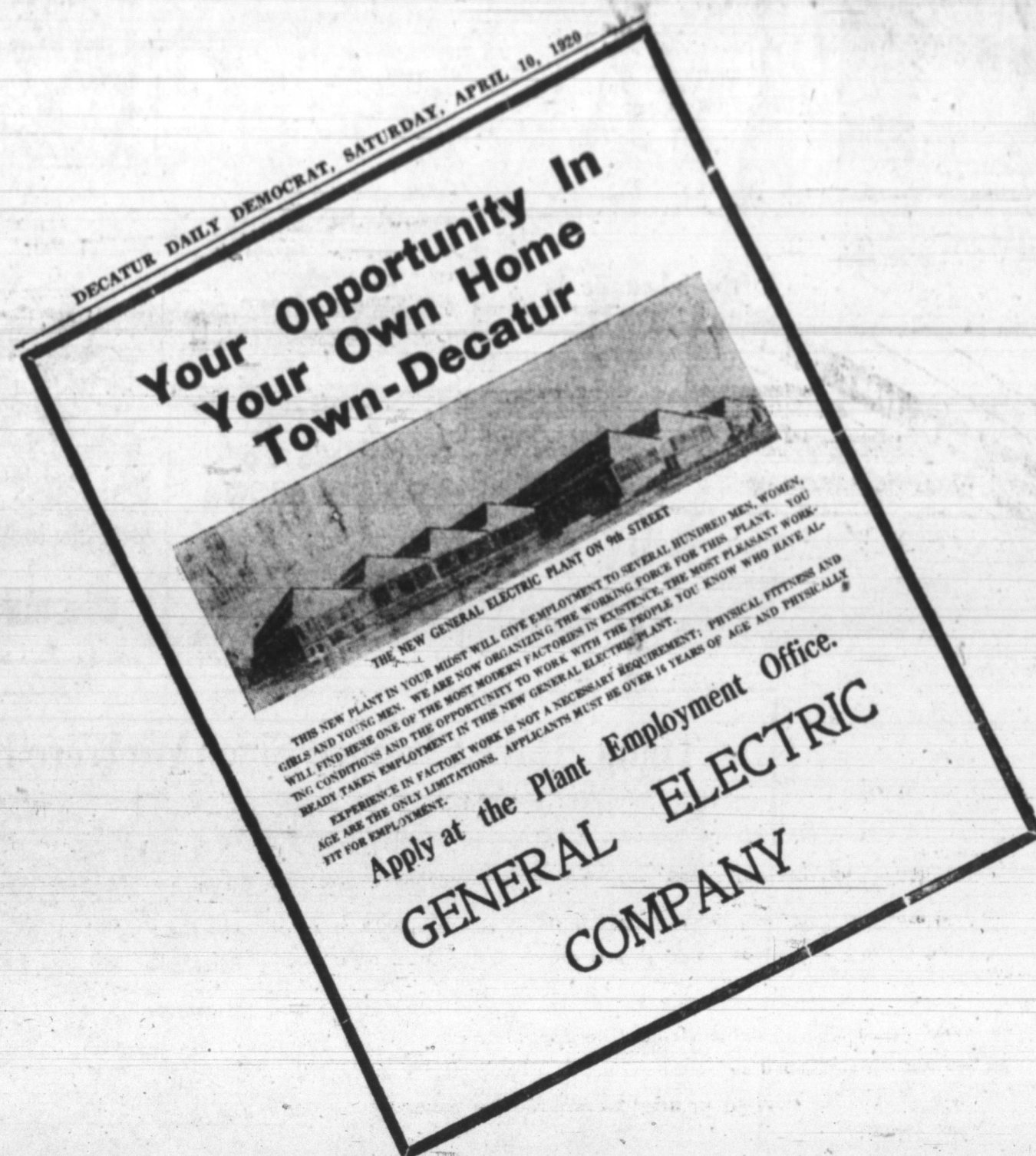


OUT OF GE'S PAST COMES A Promise of the Future for Decatur!



If you compare the original General Electric plant in Decatur (see shaded area in the artist's sketch of the present factory at the bottom of the page) with the present layout, you have some indication of the over-all progress made in the past 40 years by General Electric in Decatur.

From a single building of 61,200 square feet of floor space in 1920, General Electric has grown to include two buildings in 1960 of more than 172,300 square feet.

In this same period, employment has grown to exceed 700, with an annual payroll in excess of \$3,000,000.

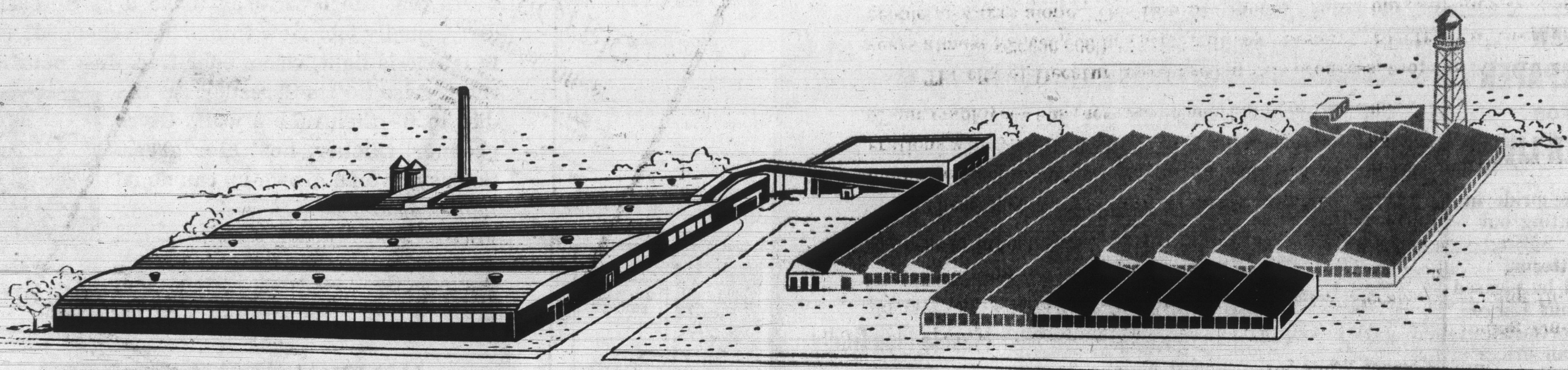
Forty years ago this month General Electric opened the doors of its new plant in Decatur. At that time we told the people of Decatur this was "your opportunity in your own home town--Decatur."
