## Budget Committee Studies Requests

INDIANAPOLIS (UPI) — The Indiana State Budget Committee is scheduled to tour several state institutions today and then journey to Purdue University to consider requests for millions of dollars in construction funds.

Included on the agenda is \$5,208,720 in construction requests as well as requests from state institutions for use of their own funds to continue improvement projects. Several minor requests also will be considered for salary increases.

The committee will tour Logansport State Hospital this morning and the Soldiers Home at Lafayette this afternoon. The regular meeting to consider requests for money will be held tonight and the committee will wind up its two-day tour with an all-day session at Purdue Friday.

Construction requests include: Norman Beatty Hospital—\$2,900 to enclose tunnel recesses. LaRue Carter Hospital—\$7,500 to install kitchen equipment.

Fort Wayne State School — \$1,036,436 for construction of a ward building at Parker Place, new site of the school. Muscatatuck State School — \$1,000 for a water and sewage survey.

Blind School—\$1,456 to install floodlights around the grounds and parking lots; \$4,505 to install a 20-foot concrete drive around the tower entrance and a walk; \$1,118 to install wiring for electric stoves and refrigeration equipment; \$1,000 to install exhaust fans in two kitchens.

Deaf School—\$11,000 to replace doors in several buildings; \$1,450 to repair plaster in several buildings; \$18,500 relocate laundry.

Soldiers and Sailors Children's Home—\$6,350 to repair breeching in boiler room; \$7,400 to repair roofs and gutters; \$2,875 to repair cooler rooms.

State Prison—\$12,250 to resurface power house floor; \$32,300 to repair kitchen and buy new equipment; \$3,100 to replace roof on administration building; \$10,500 new transformer.

State Reformatory—\$10,000 new power house; \$30,620 for equipment in vocational training building. State Farm—\$1,200 refrigeration unit; \$1,400 new roof on laundry building.

Boy's School—\$1,500 replace gutters on power house. Girl's School—\$360.00 repair gutters and roofs on eight cottages. State Police—\$3,000 additional for garage at Charlestown.

Adjutant General—\$1,000 install heating coil Remington Armory; \$70,308 new armory at Tell City. State Library—\$4,500 install shelving in warehouse.

## Pirates Score Sixth Win In Row Wednesday

Go no further than Vets Law's 1.00 earned run average and Bob Skinner's .390 batting average if you're looking for reasons why the Pittsburgh Pirates look like the comeback kids of 1960.

One of the biggest disappointments of 1959, the Pirates lead the National League by one game today and their six-game winning streak equals the best they put together last season. In fact, it is only one game short of the longest streak any NL team achieved last season.

And there's no doubt that Law, a 30-year-old, 200-pound right-hander, and Skinner, a gangling 190-pound outfielder, have been the key reasons for the turnaround.

Third Complete Game  
Law turned in his third straight complete-game victory of the season and Skinner drove in two runs with a 2-for-2 performance Wednesday night when the Pirates shaded the Philadelphia Phillies, 3-2, to go one full game ahead of the idle San Francisco Giants.

The Milwaukee Braves swept a two-game series from their favorite cousins when they whipped the Cincinnati Reds, 8-5, and the Los Angeles Dodgers beat the Chicago Cubs, 9-4, in the other NL games. In the American League, the Kansas City Athletics dealt the Detroit Tigers a second straight loss, 3-1, the Washington Senators defeated the New York Yankees, 5-4, and the Baltimore Orioles scored an 8-3 win over the Boston Red Sox.

Hank Aaron drove in two runs with a homer and three singles and also contributed a spectacular rally-killing catch in the outfield to pace the Braves' triumph. Carlton Willey received credit for the win.

Moon Sparks Dodgers  
Wally Moon had a triple, double and single and stole a base to lead the Dodgers' late-inning assault on reliever Don Elston, who was rapped for seven runs and seven hits in the final three sessions.

Ray Herbert supplied the pitching and Bob Cerv the muscle for the Athletics, who handed Hank Aguirre his first defeat, Herbert, winning his second game, struck out five and tossed a six-hitter.
