

Racer Trusts Wife's Ability To Drive Car

INDIANAPOLIS (UPI) — Defending champion Roger Ward of the 500-mile auto race is one of those rare husbands who trusts his wife's ability to handle a car.

Jo Ward, the beauty who is married to the 1959 champ of the Memorial Day Classic, explained "at least I guess he thinks I'm a good driver. He goes to sleep when I drive. That seems like a pretty high tribute."

Ward is defending not only his title at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway but also the United States Auto Club national championship which he won by adding victories at Milwaukee, DuQuoin, Ill., and the Hoosier Hundred last year. Whenever a driver goes the circuit, as he does, it means many miles of highway travel, often at night.

"Usually I take the wheel from 10 o'clock at night until morning," Mrs. Ward said. "I like night driving. My husband says I seem to become exhilarated whenever the clock hands reach 10 p. m."

No Accident Yet
Mrs. Ward admitted modestly that she hasn't had an accident with their car in the five years of their marriage.

"The only one I ever had was years ago when I was working at the U. S. Naval Operating base in California," she said. "I had been driving for a year and I was backing up on the parking lot. Guess whose car I hit? The chief's!"

"But I really am frightened about one thing when it comes to driving. I'm afraid of getting a ticket. Just think how that would sound now that my husband is a highway safety lecturer."

Many of the 10,000 fan letters which Mrs. Ward has helped answer for her husband this past year are from children, and most of his lectures on traffic safety are before high school pupils.

"Roger is very sincere about writing and talking to children so

they understand," his wife said. "They ask many questions about accidents. They want to know what happened."

Ward has two sons by a former marriage who live in El Monte, Calif., with their mother and stepfather. But Charles, 18, and David, 15, will not be at the track next Monday to see their father in action.

"School is more important than the race," Mrs. Ward said. "Quite a few drivers and their wives are finding that out. I know the

Her reference was to Mr. and Mrs. Len Sutton, Portland, Ore., who have two children, and Mr. and Mrs. Jack Turner, Seattle, Wash., who have one child.

Bible Helps in Stress
"Another thing. It's an awful experience to put a child through if his father gets hurt or anything. They are not equipped mentally and physically to take it, in case of an accident."

Mrs. Ward has her own formula

for handling periods of emotional stress.

"I go to the Bible," she said. "I'm a firm believer in it, and no matter what has happened, I find my answer in it."

Mrs. Ward, a native of Bisbee, Ariz., lived briefly in St. Louis, Mo., before going to live with an aunt and uncle in California.

"My uncle was a great fan of auto racing, and I often went to races with him. In fact, I met Roger at Gilmore (near Los Angeles). It's to midget racers what

the Indianapolis Speedway is to big car drivers."

"I like horse races, too," Mrs. Ward added. "We never miss the Kentucky Derby. But I do wish we could get a seat. Maybe by the time Roger has won the 500 three times in a row, the derby people will remember the name when we write for tickets."

an explanation of hospital regulations tended to the latter.

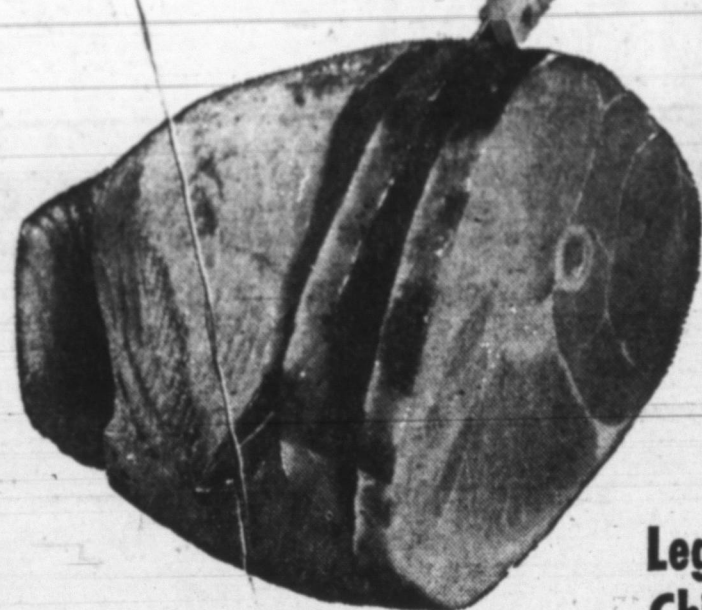
No 'Moo' About It
