Social Security Quiz

Answers Many Queries

(Editor's Note) Do you have any questions about Social Security? We all do, don't we? Send any question you might have to Social Security Quiz, c/o Daily Democrat. You'll find your answer in this column, which is published regularly.)

1. Q—My social security card has my name spelled with "two e's", and my employer's records show it with only one. Does this matter? If it does, what should I do about it?

A—That depends on which spelling is correct. If your employer's record is correct, then visit your nearest social security office and ask for a form to correct your social security record. They will issue you a new card with your name spelled correctly. If your social security record is correct, then you should have your employer correct his records.

2. Q—I am receiving my old-age retirement payments. I understand that if I want to get all my benefits, I must limit my earnings to \$1,200 in a calendar year. I now earn this amount in wages. If I work a little as a self-employed person and do not net \$400 a year, will the amount I earn from self-employment, say about \$350, count toward the \$1,200?

A—Yes, it will. In any year that you are under 72, all earnings, whether or not covered by social security, will count in the amount you are allowed to earn while receiving benefits. If you have earnings from wages or self-employment, regardless of the amount, you must count them all in figuring your annual earnings after you retire.

3. Q—I retired in 1952 and started to receive benefits. I have received two increases when the law was changed. After I retired, I never went back to work. If I go down to the social security office now, could they increase my benefit?

A—No, they could not. If you haven't worked since you retired, there could be no increase in your benefit.

4. Q—I am under age 72 and eligible for social security benefits. How can I get social security checks for some months even though I earn over \$1,200 a year? I would like to have the number of checks you can receive for the year. For every \$80 or part of \$80 you earn over the \$1,200, one month's benefit will be withheld. For example, if you earn \$1,201.01, one month's check is withheld; if you earn \$1,280.01, two month's checks; and if you earn \$2,080.01, all 12 month's checks are withheld. On the other hand no matter how much you earn in the year, you can receive your monthly payment for any month in which you neither earn wages of more than \$100 nor render services in self-employment. This means that even though you

earn over \$2,080 in the year, you may still get benefits for some months.

5. Q—I am receiving social security disability payments. May I earn as much as \$1,200 a year before any of my monthly checks are withheld?

A—Since you are getting social security payments because of a disability, the earnings rules which apply to other beneficiaries do not apply to you. As soon as you go to work, you must notify your social security office at once.

First Kill Scored

WASHINGTON (UPI)— The Army says one of its Nike-Hercules anti-aircraft missiles has achieved the first known kill of a guided ballistic missile by another rocket.

The service announced Friday that the Hercules shot down a Corporal missile a week ago at the White Sands, N.M. missile range.

The Army called the shot an "experiment" and acknowledged that it had "no direct relation" to the program for developing a weapon capable of knocking down intercontinental ballistic missiles which fly far faster, higher and further than the Corporal.
