ORDINANCE

SHORT TITLE — An ordinance concerning construction and maintenance of sewers and water lines in the Town of Monroe, Adams County, Indiana, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof. BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Monroe, Adams County, Indiana, as follows: Section 1. It is hereby declared unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to construct or maintain any privy, cesspool, septic tank, sewer or any other source of contamination with two hundred (200) feet of any source of water supply owned by the Town of Monroe, Adams County, Indiana. Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation who shall be found guilty of the violation of this ordinance, shall on conviction be fined any sum not exceeding \$1,000 dollars, to which may be added imprisonment not to exceed 180 days. Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this ordinance. Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, according to the Statutes of the State of Indiana.
