Fort Wayne's G.E. Walkout Is Settled

FORT WAYNE, Ind. (UPI) — About 5,000 electrical workers were scheduled to return to their jobs today at three General Electric Corp. plants here following agreement on a labor dispute which ended a two-day walkout.

Members of Local 901 of the

International Union of Electrical Workers set up picket lines Monday after charging the company with promoting younger workers over the heads of employees with more seniority.

But local union president Cecil R. Onion and G. E. spokesman Charles E. Slater reached agreement on the matter Tuesday and the picket lines were withdrawn Tuesday evening.

Slater and Onion said in a joint statement that a compromise set-

tlement was reached whereby long-service employees would in the future be given preference on job assignments.

BLOOMINGTON, Ind. (UPI) — Indiana University's trustees have approved an academic budget of \$28,585,642 for the coming year, a nine per cent increase over the budget of the current year.

Soya Names Kenyon M-R Superintendent

He joined the company April 27, 1943 in the M & R department of its Marion, Ohio, plant. The following year he became M & R superintendent at Marion, and in 1948 was named M & R superintendent at Central's Memphis, Tenn., plant.

Car Thief Sentenced To State Reformatory

Leslie Walker, a slow moving Negro from Cleveland, Miss., was sentenced Tuesday to not less than a year or more than 10 years in the Indiana state reformatory at Pendleton.

Walker, who is 27 years old, took a car from the home of Joel Neuenschwander of Berne on the night of June 1, and was captured by an alert service station attendant on the morning of June 4. He was returned to Decatur and found guilty at his trial last Thursday, although sentence was not passed until Tuesday. Walker will be taken by the Sheriff's department sometime this week.

Ralph McClain, a native of Berne, has been named principal of the James H. Smart school in Fort Wayne for the next school year. He was principal of the South Wayne school during the past year.
