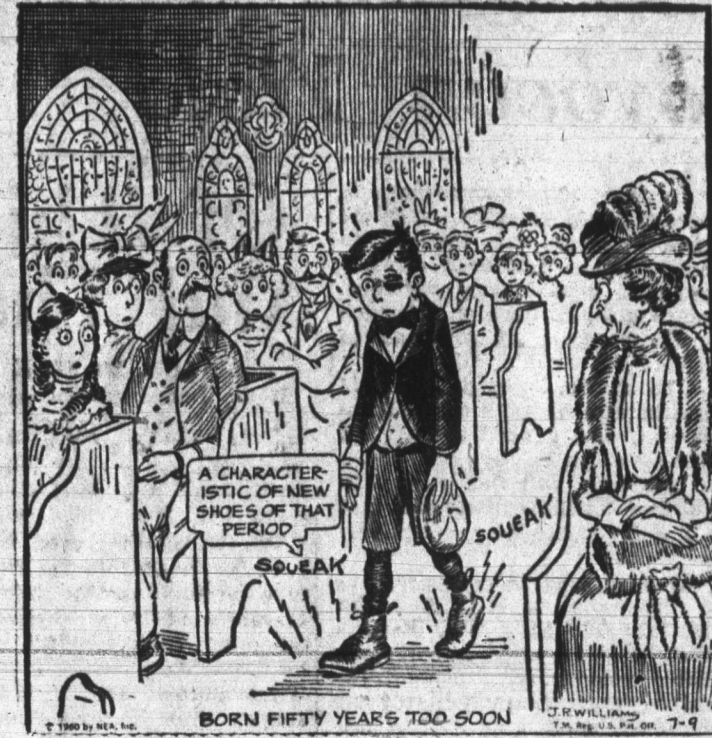

Estate Cases
