## Young Gunman Robs Bank At Bunker Hill

BUNKER HILL, Ind. (UPD)—A young bandit held up a branch bank near a big Air Force base today and fled with an undetermined amount of cash.

Police said they learned the man got between \$2,000 and \$3,000. The gunman, described as a Negro about 20 years old, held up a woman teller and forced her to fill a sack with currency of denominations ranging from \$5 to \$20.

Then he walked to a waiting automobile and escaped before other employees were aware a robbery had occurred.

There were no customers in the bank when the man walked in about 10:45 a.m. and approached teller Carolyn Phillipy. He pulled out a revolver, laid it on the counter and ordered Miss Phillipy to fill a sack with bills from the cash drawer behind the counter.

He cautioned Miss Phillipy not to scream. She filled the bag and the man walked out, entered a car identified as a 1955 white model, and headed south.

State police immediately set up roadblocks in the area.

Bunker Hill is a small town near Bunker Hill Air Force Base.

The bank was the Bunker Hill branch of the Wabash Valley Trust Co., which has headquarters and the main bank at nearby Peru.

The gunman was described as of medium build and wearing a tan sports shirt and tan cap.
