Chester H. (Chet) Kleinknight

The death Saturday of Chet Kleinknight from heart trouble after four weeks' hospitalization removes from our community one of the most active and understanding sports enthusiast and backer that the young people of Decatur have known.

Mr. Kleinknight was one of the original Little League managers, having been in charge of the Red Sox for two years, starting in 1953. He helped to organize the Pony League, and managed the Braves for four years. He also coached the All-Star team.

A member of the Zion Lutheran church, his big project for many years has been coaching the basketball and baseball teams in circuit A of the Lutheran League. His team has won the championship several times, was runner-up this past year, and he had one undefeated season. In addition, he was formerly a Sunday School teacher, and has substituted for the past two years. A past secretary of the congregation, he has been active as an usher.

For 15 or 20 years he was active as a referee in industrial and high school basketball circles, retiring from that arduous task eight or ten years ago.

A great part of Mr. Kleinknight's time was dedicated to helping young people, and his fellow workers knew him as a man who understood teenagers and their problems, and could get 100% out of every boy. He had that knack of getting along that made him an outstanding man in this community.

A former athlete himself at his home-town of Tocson, he played here in semi-pro basketball circles for several years.

For 38 years he was a trusted employee of the General Electric plant in Decatur, and was a member of the planning department at the time of his death.

He had returned this year from a course in planning in the east at which he was the only man without a college degree, showing the great trust and responsibility placed on his shoulders by his employers.

Chet Kleinknight was the kind of man that every community admires, respects and remembers for his devotion to others, for his work to see that every boy got a chance to play, and be "on the team."
