## Hoover Scores Religion As Issue In 1960

NEW YORK (UPI) — Herbert Hoover took the occasion of his 86th birthday anniversary today to voice his disgust at religious bigotry and state it would be "a dreadful idea" to inject in the presidential campaign.

Hoover in 1928 defeated the first Roman Catholic ever to run for the United States presidency; the Democratic candidate, Alfred E. Smith.

This year's Democratic candidate, Sen. John F. Kennedy of Massachusetts, is the second Catholic in history to seek the candidacy. His Republican opponent, Vice President Richard M. Nixon, is, like Hoover, a member of the Society of Friends (Quaker) Church.

### Fire In Voice

In a news conference held Tuesday with reporters who requested a birthday interview, Hoover was reminded of the religious sentiment against Smith in that election and asked how he felt about the issue's being raised again in the present campaign.

There was fire in his voice when he replied: "I think it's just a dreadful idea. In the 1928 campaign I must have denounced it half a dozen times."

He added, however, that the 1928 campaign differed from the present one in that "in the Southern states then prohibition was an issue and also they tended to identify Smith with Tammany Hall."

Smith was an anti-prohibitionist in the "wet vs. dry" issue. Asked again his feeling about injection of the religious issue in the 1960 campaign, Hoover replied: "I abhor the whole idea of bigotry in every form, and I don't know how many thousands of times I've expressed myself on this."

### Optimistic About Future

Hoover would not express himself on political questions other than to say he was glad to see the younger generation taking over and to observe: "You will naturally expect any man who has been honored by his party with the presidency to vote the ticket of his party—and I have no doubt you will find that also applies to my friend, former President Truman."

Asked about the future for America, the former president said: "I don't believe this republic is in its decline and fall. With growing strength and determination, we can influence the expansion of freedom in the world." At 86, the former president is hard at work—with a big bowl of yellow wooden pencils and eight busy secretaries—on completion of his four-volume "An American Epic." It tells how American charity has saved 1.4 billion lives in the last 45 years. He works a 10-hour day. The second volume comes out next month, the third is in proof, the fourth two-thirds completed.
