### 20 Years Ago Today

Jan. 3, 1942 — L. E. Archbold, Adams county agricultural agent, has been named county chairman of a committee to salvage waste materials as part of the war effort.

Bixler, assistant fire chief.

Fire losses in Berne during 1941 totaled \$3,435, a decrease from the \$4,117.44 loss in 1940.

Sealed bids will be received by the Board of School Trustees of the Decatur School City of Decatur, Indiana, on the (1) general construction, (2) heating and ventilation, (3) plumbing and sewerage, (4) electrical power, (5) construction equipment and (6) arts and crafts equipment required for the construction of an addition to the Decatur Senior High School Building, until 8:00 A.M. (EST) Tuesday, January 23, 1962, in the presence of the school board, at which time and place all bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. Bids received after such time will be rejected as non-responsive.

Bidders may submit combined bids on any of the above classifications.

Proposals or bids shall be accompanied by a non-collusion affidavit as required by the Statutes of Indiana, and must be accompanied by a questionnaire Form 96A, State Board of Accounts, for all bids of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) or more as required by law.

Each bid or proposal shall be accompanied by an acceptable certificate of bidder's check payable to the School City of Decatur, Indiana, in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid price. Surety bonds will be required to furnish payment and performance bond with acceptable surety thereon in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of each contract awarded. Said bonds to be supplied in all respects with the requirements of the Statutes of Indiana governing bonds to be furnished by school boards for contracts let by a school board.

Wage rates on this work shall be not less than the prescribed scale of wages as determined pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 319 of the 1933 Acts of the General Assembly of Indiana, a copy of which may be had from the work being part of the specifications.
