The Indianapolis symphony orchestra, a highlight of the program each year, has already been scheduled. But the rest of the programs will depend on the number of memberships sold.

Mrs. Roy Kalver heads the entire program, and Mrs. J. Clark Mayclin heads the drive in Decatur.

All new members who sign up now will be able to attend the bonus concert this year, Stan Freeman on April 12.

Those who have never attended the programs are missing a fine opportunity for relaxation, enjoyment, and a fine social evening right here in Decatur. The programs are of such quality that few large cities have any better.

A city is often measured by the programs that its citizens support. No finer recommendation can be given for Decatur than its excellent civic music program. If you take part, you help strengthen this important aspect of Adams county's civic life.
