(part of the Berne-French Township School) shall be assumed by the proposed South Adams Community Schools. Sections Twenty-seven and Twenty-eight of the Monroe Township (part of the present Adams County Central School Corporation) shall jointly assume, along with the remainder of the reorganized Adams County Central School, the liabilities of the Adams County Schools. Taxes levied and assessed from the northern one-mile area of French Township, sections one (1) through Twenty-six (26) and area north of the Wabash River in Sections Twenty-seven (27) through Twenty-eight (28), Adams County, shall and lease rental payment shall go to the South Adams Community Schools for the remainder of the calendar year 1962. northern two (2) mile area of Washington Township (part of present Adams County Central School Corporation) shall be assumed by the proposed Adams County Community Schools and this area of northern two (2) mile area of Washington Township shall jointly with the remainder of the administrative unit assume the liabilities of the proposed North Adams Community Schools. The southern two (2) mile area of northern two (2) mile area of Washington Township, sections one through 12, exclusive of the Civil City of Decatur, for bonded indebtedness of the Adams Central Community Schools shall go to the Adams Central Community Schools for the rest of the calendar years of 1962. This payment shall be based on the present population of the public schools subject to the total of resident pupils in Washington Township, a part

to the present Adams County Central Consolidated School. The North Adams Community Schools shall have the right to receive sufficient amount to pay the interest and principal of the Root Civil Aid Bonds of Root Civil Township, as provided in Section 18 of Chapter 202 of the Acts of 1939, as amended by Chapter 322 of the Acts of 1941, and Chapter 20 of the Acts of 1943, 20th and December 20th of each year until bonds are retired to the Civil Township Trustee of Root Township, Adams County, Indiana. The first payment shall be made as of June 20th following the June distribution of taxes from the County Auditor.

b. The proposed North Adams Community Schools shall assume the assets and liabilities of the Adams County Textbook Rental Association on a per pupil basis of students from the County Schools to the proposed administrative unit.

**Assets and Liabilities**

Table 1.22 shows the assets and liabilities of the School Corporations in Adams County. The value of the school buses were ascertained by the transportation committee, who used a fixed depreciation standard for the original cost of the equipment. The value of the assets of the School City of Ellettsburg, Ellettsburg French School Corporation, and Berne-French Township Consolidated School Corporations are insurance values, while the Township School Corporations assets were determined by the original costs less depreciation.

12. The Special Election shall be governed by the General Election Laws, including the registration laws of this State, insofar as they may be applicable.

13. Such Special Election shall be under the direction of the Adams County Election Board, and such Election Board shall take all steps necessary to carry out the election.
