\$2 Million Grant
To Aid Education

NEW YORK (UPI)—The Ford Foundation today announced a grant of \$2 million to the American Council on Education to finance half the cost of a major reorganization of the council "to enable it to keep pace with growing demands on the nation's system of higher education."

The announcement said a grant of \$975,000 was awarded to the University of Chicago for a cooperative program with 37 liberal arts colleges in the Midwest to recruit and prepare students for college teaching careers.

The 37 colleges are Antioch, Augustana (Ill.), Barat College of the Sacred Heart, Beloit, Butler University, Calvin, Carleton, Coe, Cornell, Denison University, DePauw University, Earlham, Grinnell, Hope, Kalamazoo, Kenyon, Knox, Lake Forest, Lawrence, Luther, Milwaukee-Dowder, Monmouth (Ill.), North Central, North Park, Oberlin, Ripon, Rockford, Rosary, College of St. Catherine, St. Olaf, College of St. Thomas, St. Xavier, Shimer, Valparaiso University, Wheaton (Ill.), Wilberforce University, and Wooster.
