## 'Modular' Panel Saves You Money

"Modular dimensions" sounds very technical, but it simply means that the sizes of building materials are based on standard building measurements so that they will fit with a minimum of cutting.

For instance, Marlite planks are eight feet long, a dimension which corresponds to a typical wall height in most houses. The planks' 16-inch width will divide evenly into many typical wall widths. Nine planks, for example, will fit a 12-foot wall.

Marlite blocks are ideal for ceilings because they are easy to install and can be damp-wiped clean. The plastic-surfaced blocks never require painting.

Local lumber dealers carry the paneling and matching moldings. Complete installation instructions are included in each package. Marlite can be installed over old walls or new framing, thus simplifying most improvement projects.

## Artists Paint On Marlite Panel

The artist in the family can make good use of pieces of Marlite paneling left over from a remodeling project.

Since this paneling is pre-decorated, it presents a ready-made background for still-life pictures of fruit or flowers, for instance. The paneling holds oil paints well.

Plain colors and woodgrains provide the most appropriate background. Marlite can be cut into interesting shapes, such as squares or circles, before the painting is started.

The sturdy predecorated hardboard paneling can be hung as soon as the oils dry. No frame is necessary because the decorative finish provides a "built-in" frame. If desired, the edges can be stained.

For easy application, Marlite planks and blocks have tongue-and-groove edges.

### Leaks in Tubeless Tires

When a small leak in a tubeless auto tire refuses to show a bubble when submerged in water, look the tire over carefully and put a small dab of mastic or liquid glue on every indentation that could possibly be a leak. The mastic or glue will reveal a small leak where water will fall.

### Slack on Silk

When removing stains from silk and other fine fabrics, you'll often find that a compactly rolled piece of paper makes a better applicator for the cleaning fluid than a cloth pad. The roll will not only apply the fluid without injuring the fabric, but the wet paper tends to loosen foreign matter more effectively than cloth. After the fabric has dried, clinging particles of paper are removed by brushing.

### Household Insects

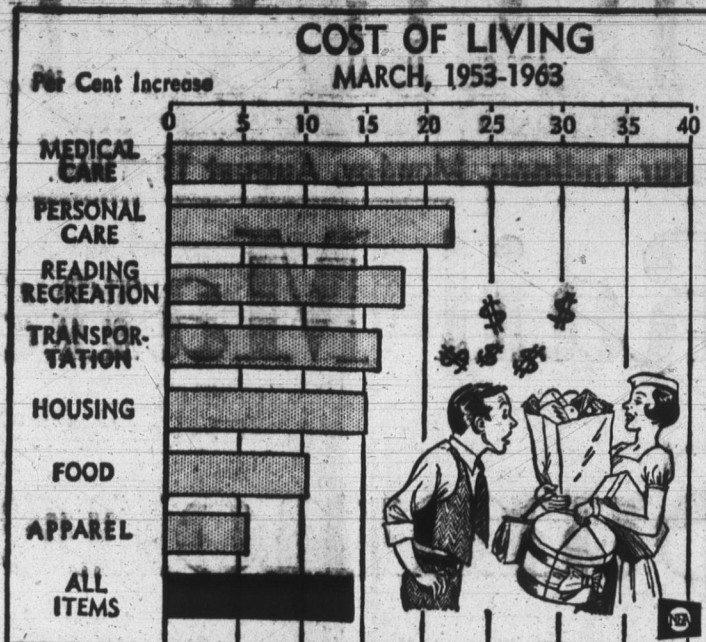
An effective way to get rid of insects in your home, when you don't want to use a spray, is to call on your tank-type vacuum cleaner. Simply aim the flexible hose and nozzle at the pests, turn on the power, and they'll be sucked in. Empty the bag, of course, outdoors.

### Bike Parking Tip

A bicycle leaned against the house or porch can sometimes scrape off the paint or possibly fall and be damaged. You can prevent this by fastening a broom clip to the porch or side of the house at the height of the handlebars, and then when you park his bike, he can snap one of the handle bars into the clip. A light jerk will disengage it.

### Lawn Sprinkler

To make an inexpensive lawn sprinkler bend a 26-inch piece of wire in the center and nine inches from each end in the shape of the letter M. Stick the ends into the ground and rest the nozzle of the hose in the center.

## Ceiling Block Resists Stains, Heat, Humidity

If your bathroom or kitchen ceilings are "tired", now is the time to install a washable material that never needs painting or refinishing.

Heat and humidity will ruin the appearance of many ceiling materials quickly, but plastic-finished Marlite ceiling block is factory-treated to withstand these conditions.

This paneling can be installed right over old ceilings. The 16-inch square blocks have tongue-and-groove edges, which simplify installation. Adhesive is used to secure a strong bond.

Marlite ceiling block, which is available at local lumber dealers, comes in white and parchment, as well as gold lace and nugget patterns. These colors and patterns blend well with most decorative themes.

This plastic-finished hardboard ceiling block can be cleaned with a damp or sudsy cloth. Even grease stains can be removed without marring the decorative finish. Periodic redecorating is not necessary.

Refinished plywood paneling is ideal for wall covering in room additions.

Acoustical tile for a new-family room will help control noise.

Wall-to-wall carpeting can be applied directly over Underlayment grade plywood.

The plywood panels used to form the foundation of a room addition can be reused later as roof sheathing to cut costs.

Experts say a good remodeling job carefully executed can add more value to a home than the actual cost of the project.

### Mildew Stains

Light mildew stains on washable fabrics often are removed by washing with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly, and dry in the sun. If a stain remains, moisten it with some lemon juice, sprinkle with salt, and place in the sun. If material is colored, use this method with caution. The acid may change the color. If so, sponge with water containing a little ammonia. Rinse and dry.

### Changing Fuses

When replacing a blown fuse, make sure that your hands are DRY and you are STANDING ON A DRY FLOOR. If your fuse box is located in the basement and the floor tends to be damp, build a wood grating, or stand on dry papers or magazines while changing your fuses.

## This Doctor Helps Rural Communities

An Iowa engineer with a law degree and a suitcase full of "wash and wear" clothes hit the road several years ago to see if there really was a need for specialized design and construction experience in the medical building field.

Local contractors handle the construction. Casework, which contains specially-designed sinks and storage areas, is shipped in to form one wall in each examination-consultation room. This eliminates the problems of finding local firms that can produce special casework at a reasonable price.

Special wall panels also are shipped directly to the job to speed construction and simplify maintenance in the future. The in-

terior side of the hollow-core panels is decorative Marlite, whose plastic surface can be damp-wiped clean. Dirt, chemicals and hard wear will not affect the paneling. In addition, predecorated Marlite never needs painting or refinishing.

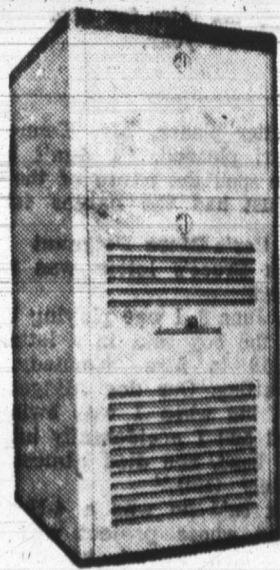

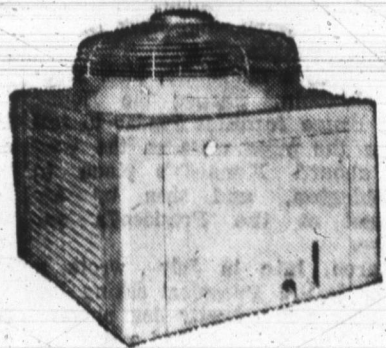

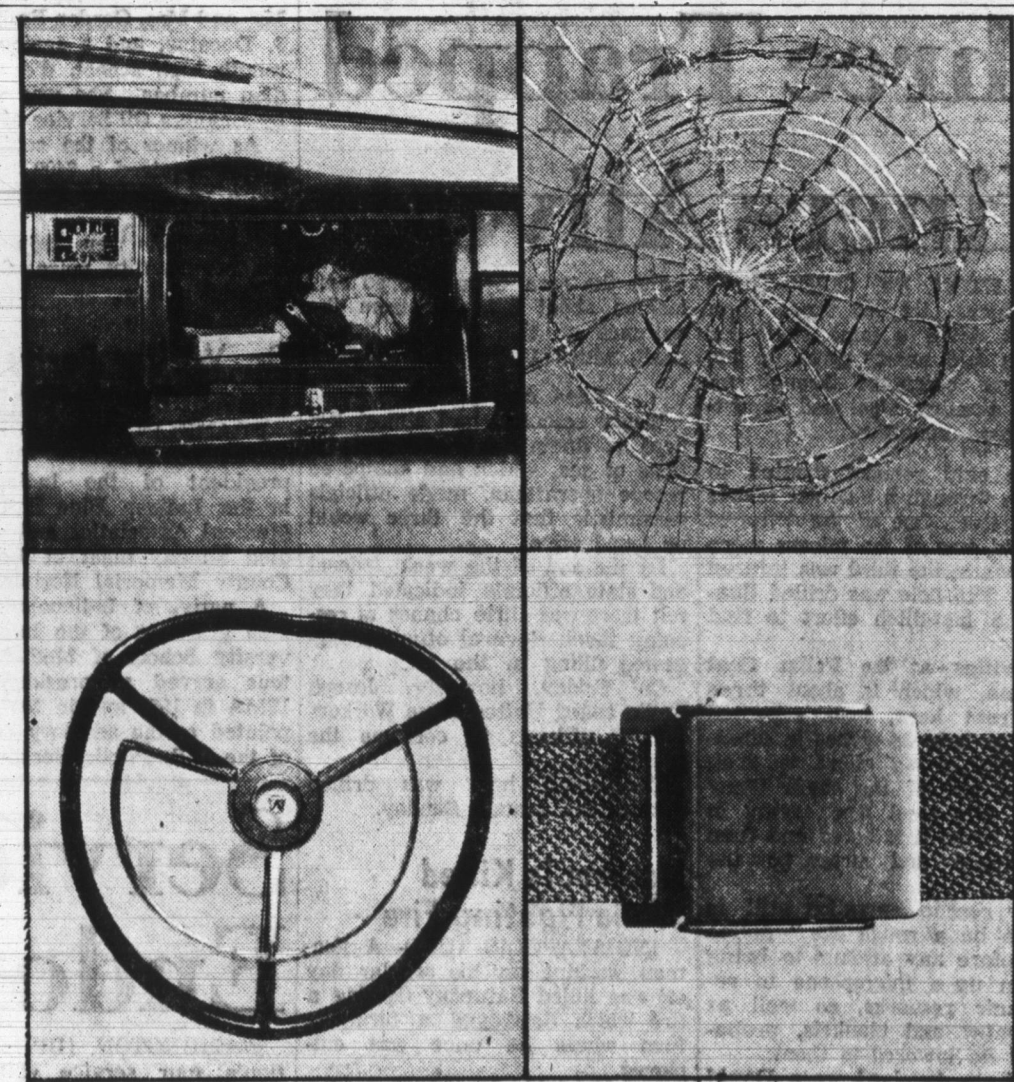
