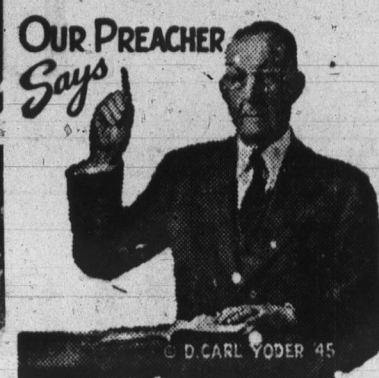


COME TO CHURCH SUNDAY
