



## Geneva Loses To Madison In Overtime

Failure to cash in on free throws cost the Geneva Cardinals their first defeat of the season Saturday night, with the Madison township club of Jay county racking up a 54-49 victory in an overtime battle.

The Jay county quintet piled up a 14-8 lead in the first quarter, but the Cardinals came back to take a 23-21 advantage at the half.

Geneva increased its lead to 33-26 after three periods, but Madison came back to knot the score at 47-47 at the expiration of the regular playing time. The visitors collected seven points in the overtime session to only two for the Cardinals.

Jerry Alperton, of Geneva, led all scorers with 18 points. Ron Bollenbacher added 14 and Mike Newcomer 11 for the Cardinals, who converted only 13 of 31 free throw chances. Kunkle topped Madison with 16 points and Denny Van Dool counted 14.

The Cardinals, with a season record of 1-1, will tangle with the Berne Bears at Berne Friday night.



## Eagles Down Elmhurst By 52-48 Score

The Monmouth Eagles registered their fourth consecutive victory Saturday night as they surprised the favored Elmhurst Trojans, 52-48, at the Elmhurst gym.

The win gave the Eagles a 4-2 season record, and for Elmhurst it was the second loss in five starts.

Saturday's battle was close all the way. The teams were tied at 9-9 at the first quarter and the Trojans held a scant two-point advantage, 24-22, at the half. The Eagles overcame a five-point deficit midway in the third period and the quintets were again knotted, 34-34 at the end of the quarter. Elmhurst was in front, 40-36, halfway through the final stanza but the Eagles scored six straight points to take the lead and stayed in front of the rest of the way.

Bob Brandt, veteran Monmouth guard, was the game's top scorer with 17 points, the only Eagle in double figures. Tom Mullans scored 10 to lead Elmhurst. The Eagles cashed 20 of 23 attempts from the free throw line, the Trojans 14 of 23.


The Eagles have a pair of home games this week, hosting Roanoke Friday night and Eastside (Butler) Saturday night.
