## Gasoline Ordinance.

An Ordinance regulating the storing of Gasoline within the boundaries of the City of Decatur, fixing a penalty for the violation thereof, and declaring an emergency.

Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Decatur, Indiana, that it shall be unlawful for any person to keep or store more than five gallons of gasoline within the following prescribed limits of the said city, viz: All that part of the said city bounded on the east by the St. Marys River; on the north by Jackson street; on the west by Fourth street, and on the south by Adams street.

Sec. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or store more than one barrel of gasoline at any place in the said city without the boundary lines fixed in Section one (1) hereof.

Sec. 3. It shall be unlawful for the owner of any building or other structure, or of any vacant lot or tract of land lying within said city, to permit any tenant or occupant to keep or store at, in or upon such building, or other structure or vacant lot or tract of land, gasoline in greater quantities than is specified in Sections one (1) and two (2) hereof.

Sec. 4. All gasoline whenever kept or stored in the said city, shall be kept or stored in an air-tight metal can or receiver, and it shall be unlawful for any person to take or draw gasoline therefrom, at any time, except during day light. And such gasoline shall be kept or stored not less than twenty (20) feet from the place where the owner or occupant of such real estate uses any artificial light.

Sec. 5. Any person violating any or either of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction before the Mayor, be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars.

Sec. 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and second consecutive publication in the Decatur Democrat, the weekly newspaper, printed and published in said city of Decatur, Indiana.
