Taxes for the Year of 1907

Notice is hereby given that the taxes levied for the State, County, School and other purposes in Adams County, Indiana, are due and payable at the Treasurer's Office in said County, in the City of Decatur, in full and even of tax-payer, one-half, including road taxes in full, on or before the FIRST MONDAY IN MAY, 1908, the same being

Monday, May 4, 1908

The second half (in case the first half is paid when due) becomes due and payable on or before the FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER, 1908, the same being

Monday, November, 2, 1908

Road Tax Receipts

Should be presented on or before the FIRST MONDAY IN MAY, as the road tax is all included in the first installment. Road tax receipts will not be taken for the second installment of taxes. Examine your receipts before leaving the office, and see that all your property is described. Also see that change is correctly made.

Particular Attention

Those who have lands and lots, or other property, in more than one township, must see that they have a receipt for all.

County Orders cannot be paid to any person owing delinquent taxes. All persons are warned against purchasing such orders. The Books will POSITIVELY BE CLOSED on the FIRST MONDAY IN MAY and the FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER.
