HE SHOT HIM

Young Man Killed by Policeman at Fort Wayne.

Henry Schmidt a painter, twenty two years of age who resided at 1119 Erie street was shot and killed by Policeman John Greer, about 2:30 o'clock yesterday afternoon while running away from the officer, who had a warrant for his arrest. The shooting took place in front of the residence of Central Buechner, at 100 Cochran street and was witnessed by practically all of the people along the street. Only a few minutes after he was hit and when Dr E. J. McOscar who was summoned to the scene arrived he found the boy dead. Great excitement followed the shooting and Officer Greer and Officer Spillner who was with him, escaped rough treatment at the hands of the crowd which quickly assembled, only by threats of using their clubs. Women sobbed and cried hysterically and shouted curses at the policemen and men talked in a threatening manner. Had the patrolmen remained in the vicinity trouble might have followed.—Ft. Wayne Journal Gazette.
