

Newspaper Decisions.

1. Subscribers who do not give express notice to the contrary are considered willing to continue their subscription. 2. If a subscriber order the discontinuance of their periodical the publishers may continue to send them until all arrears are paid. 3. If a subscriber sends the office to which they are directed they are held responsible until they have settled their bills with the publisher. 4. If subscribers move to other places without informing the publishers, and the papers are sent to the former direction they are held responsible. 5. The courts have decided that the removing and leaving them uncalled for, is prima facia evidence of intentional fraud. 6. Any subscriber who receives a newspaper and makes use of it, whether he has ordered it or not, is held in law to be a subscriber. 7. If subscribers pay in advance they are bound to pay it back to the publisher at the end of their time, if they do not wish to continue taking it; otherwise the publisher is entitled to it. 8. Subscribers will be responsible until an express notice, with payment of all arrears is sent to the publisher.
