

Newspaper Decisions.

1. Subscribers who do not give express notice to the contrary are considered wishing to continue their subscription.

2. If subscribers order the discontinuance of their periodicals, all charges are paid in advance to cover all expenses are paid.

3. If subscribers neglect or refuse to take their periodicals from the office to which they are referred, the publisher is not bound to have them settled their bills and ordered them discontinued.

4. If subscribers move to other places without informing the publisher, and the publisher is unable to forward the direction, they are held responsible.

5. The courts have decided that "refusing to take periodicals from the office or returning them to the publisher, is prima facie evidence of intentional fraud."

6. Any person who receives a newspaper and makes a practice of not having it, is held in law to be a subscriber.

7. If subscribers pay in advance they are bound to give notice to the publisher at the end of their periodicals, and the publisher is bound to take it, otherwise the publisher is authorized to send it out and the subscriber will be responsible until it is paid for, and payment of all arrears is sent to the publisher.
