

**THE DRAINING ASSOCIATION.**  
The meeting for the purpose of completing the organization of The Jasper County Draining Association was held at the Court House Saturday afternoon in session with previous notice. S. P. Thompson was chosen president and Granville Moody, Sec'y. pro tem. By a vote of the meeting, the objects and purposes of the Association were limited to simply acquiring and removing the mill dam and race way across the Iroquois at Rensselaer. One of the articles of association adopted at the meeting required the election of a board of five directors who should have control of the business of the Association, and who could appoint one of their number to serve as president of the board, another as secretary, another as superintendent, and another as solicitor. The directors are elected for one year and elections of directors are to be held on the second Saturday in April, of each year as long as the association exists.

After the consideration and adoption of articles of association, the meeting proceeded to elect a board of Directors. The following being chosen unanimously:

Alfred Thompson, Addison Parkison, S. P. Thompson, J. H. Loughridge, and Granville Moody.

At the adjournment of the stockholders' meeting, the board of Directors held a session, and made the following appointment of the officers of the board: President, Addison Parkison; Secretary, Alfred Thompson; Superintendent, J. H. Loughridge; Solicitor, S. P. Thompson.
