

The Secretary of the Prison Reform Association has attempted a reply to Secretary of State Myers, in which he states that Fraud Hayes was elected as President of the organization on the (false) assumption that he had been President of the United States. If Hayes has a particle of manhood in his composition the galling fact will ever be present with him that he never was President—that at most he was only acting President by virtue of the fraud and perjury committed by those who counted him in.
