The Poisonous Oleander.
The oleander with its beautiful rose-colored flowers is a plant frequently cultivated, but there are not very many who know that the oleander belongs to the poisonous plants. It is well to remember, when cultivating it as a house-plant, that under some circumstances it is very noxious. Pliny said of the oleander that it was poisonous, and later discoveries have confirmed this. In Madrid, a few years since, there was a case of poisoning by eating birds broiled on oleander leaves. In the south of Italy and Spain, the scraped rind of the tree is used as a rat-poison and to drive away noxious insects. In both countries, the localities where oleanders grow are generally malarious. In Northern Africa, where they lend an especial charm to the scenery along the banks of the river, they are not suffered to grow near human habitations, and in this respect are really boycotted. It is remarkable that even bees avoid the oleander.—Demorest.
