New York Special.

Washington, April 6.—The Ways and Means Committee intend to report a new revenue bill Thursday next. No definite decision has yet been reached respecting the amount of tax to be imposed upon distilled spirits, tobacco and petroleum.

General Butler, accompanied by his personal staff, left this morning for Cincinnati. He is charged with special orders from the President under which he will make a complete tour of the territory claimed from the rebels, with a view of observing the temper and disposition of the people toward the United States Government, investigating the practical workings of the policy adopted in dealing with them, and expounding the purposes of the administration, and endeavoring to reconcile them to the Government. The General will make such suggestions from time to time for the modification or change of policy as may occur to him from his observations.

At Cincinnati a gunshot from Admiral Porter's fleet will be placed at the disposal of the General by which he will be conveyed to the principal points of the south-west. He will return via the sea coast, calling at all points of Federal occupation, for which purpose an armed vessel will be assigned to him by Admiral Farragut.

The President's exceedingly sanguine of the effort to restore the people to hearty allegiance by opening their eyes, which have so long been blinded by Southern politicians, and conveying to them the desire of the Government, while sternly demanding their return to loyalty, to deal with them in kindness and forbearance.
